The Football Programme

At Worksop College, we offer an extensive football programme designed to nurture talent, enhance skills, and provide pathways for pupils to excel in football. Our programme is built on a foundation of expert coaching, top-tier facilities, and strong partnerships with professional clubs, ensuring our pupils have every opportunity to succeed.

For girls in the Worksop College Girls' Football Academy (WCGFA), the programme includes:

- 2x team training sessions per week.
- 3x strength and conditioning (S&C) sessions per week.
- 1x tactical analysis classroom session per week.
- 1x small group session (max 3 players) per week.
- Transport to and from training and games with our partner clubs, including Sheffield United (Tier 2), Derby County (Tier 3), Doncaster Rovers Belles (Tier 4), and SJR Worksop (Tier 5).
